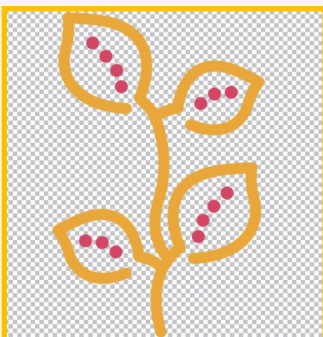

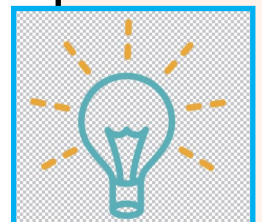

Become a Home-visiting volunteer

Home-visiting volunteers visit a family regularly for 2-3 hours once a week. The formula is a simple but effective one—a volunteer, who has parenting experience themselves, offers emotional and practical support in whatever way the parent is going to find helpful.

All home-visiting volunteers participate in a preparation course before visiting families. The preparation course is usually one day a week for six to eight weeks, and ensures the volunteers are prepared for the varying situations they may be involved with.

Volunteers attend regular supervision and group support meetings where they have the opportunity for further ongoing training and meeting other volunteers.

There is a small amount of monthly paperwork to be completed and all travel expenses are paid.
